Two other AMCs brought home Participant's Choice Top 20 Awards: the crowd-pleasing 1959 Nash Metropolitan owned by Kevin and Patti O'Connell of Tucson, and the 1965 Rambler Ambassador 990 Cross Country owned by Suzanne and Richard Edmonds. Matt Edmonds' 1972 Wagoneer was there to represent the Jeep Division in the Youth Class. The show is limited 450 cars, and this year was the earliest sell-out in the history of the show.
